- 2) *I will come prepared to lead the provided devotions each morning after breakfast with my delegates (students).*
- 3) *I will see that my delegates and I are at all required sessions and activities.*
- 4) *I will strive to talk with each of my assigned delegates concerning their personal walk with the Lord. I will allow myself to be a spiritual advisor and accountability source.*
- 5) *I will strive to make myself available for my delegates at any and all free times to encourage their fellowship and participation in activities.*
- 6) *I will strive to "keep tabs" on my delegates during the day and support them in their ministry training areas, quizzing and other activities as time allows.*
- 7) *I will see that my delegates are in their respective rooms at the appointed time each night. **I will not** go to bed until this is accomplished!*
- 8) *I will see that the Dean of Men/Women are kept informed of any problems or potential problems regarding the Youth Convention and its participants (particularly my assigned delegates).*
- 9) *I will uphold the standards of the convention and model good behavior when it comes to relationships with the opposite sex and responsible actions during my free time.*
